Backgrounder and Eligibility Criteria

Background Information

The Saint Elizabeth First Nations, Inuit and Métis (FNIM) Program is now an accredited member institution of the Société de formation et d'éducation continue (SOFEDUC) (Society of Training and Continuing Education).

The SOFEDUC defines a continuing education unit as the following: "One continuing education unit represents ten (10) hours of participation on a structured training activity organized and led by a recognized organization, led by competent trainers, and sanctioned by an evaluation."

Eligibility Criteria for Receiving Continuing Education Units for @YourSide Colleague® Courses

In order to receive CEUs for @YourSide Colleague® Courses, learners must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Learners must have read through all course content, from the beginning to the end of
 the course. Completing the final knowledge test only, even if successful, does not
 automatically qualify the learner for CEUs. Time spent in the course is logged in the
 FNIM Program's reporting system.
- Learners must achieve a **minimum grade of 70%*** on the final knowledge test for a course to be eligible to receive CEUs.

^{*}Some courses require a higher passing grade on the final knowledge test.
