2014 Saint Elizabeth Virtual CDE Study Group

Once again Saint Elizabeth is hosting, at no cost, a nation-wide virtual study group to assist regulated health professionals working with or for First Nations, Inuit and Metis populations and other partners to prepare to write the Canadian Diabetes Educator (CDE) certification exam. The virtual study group will guide and support health professionals in understanding the core competencies required by the Canadian Diabetes Educator Certification Board. Multiple strategies are utilized to support exam candidates including weekly webinars (live, and recorded for on-demand viewing), guidance and support from the CDE study group facilitator, and 24/7 access to an online Community of Learning for sharing and accessing of study resources and information.

until the CDE exam date, **May 24, 2014**. All weekly webinars will be recorded and made available to study group participants for on-demand viewing.

More information on the 2014 Canadian Diabetes Educator Certification Board Exam

The Canadian Diabetes Educator Certification Board (CDECB) is responsible for the development and administration of the certification program for Certified Diabetes Educators (CDE®) in Canada.

A Certified Diabetes Educator (CDE®) is a health professional, committed to excellence in diabetes education, who has a sound knowledge base in diabetes care/management and education processes, as well as good communication skills and who has passed the Canadian Diabetes Educator's Certification Board (CDECB) exam.

The CDE Examination

Individuals who have not previously taken or passed the CDE® examination (or whose CDE® designation have lapsed) must meet **ALL** of the following requirements to be eligible to write:

- 1. Be registered with a regulatory body in Canada as a health professional
- 2. A minimum of 800 hours of **practice** in diabetes education within the Canadian Diabetes Educator certification examination competencies.
- 3. The minimum of 800 hours of practice in diabetes education must be obtained within any duration or combination of time within the three year period that is immediately preceding the February 1 application deadline. Such experience must be obtained while the individual is fully licensed with a regulatory body as a Canadian health care professional.
- 4. **ALL** of the above must be attained while the individual is fully registered with a regulatory body in Canada as a health professional.

NOTE: Enrollment and participating in a diabetes course does NOT contribute towards the 800 hours of diabetes experience.

Examination Date & CDE Application Deadline

- 1. The examination is offered only once a year on the Saturday following the Victoria Day long weekend in May.
- 2. Next Examination Date: SATURDAY, MAY 24, 2014
- 3. Application Deadline: completed applications must be postmarked or couriered to the CDECB by no later than <u>February 1st</u>, <u>2014</u> there are no extensions.
